Paper Bin

- Newspaper (with inserts)
- Phonebooks
- Junk Mail
- Magazines
- Mixed Office Paper
- Cardboard, including corrugated, cereal boxes, snack boxes, etc. Please fold cardboard to 3'x3' size. Do not tie or bundle flattened cardboard boxes together.

Container Bin

- Aluminum & Steel Cans
- Glass bottles (clear, green & amber)
- Plastic containers coded...



These items **ARE NOT** included in the curbside recycling program:

- Plastic Bags
- Motor Oil or Pesticide Containers
- Light Bulbs or drinkware
- Aluminum foil or pie Plates
- Paint or Pesticide cans
- Electronic Devices
- Egg Cartons and Styrofoam trays

DUAL-SORT SYSTEM

What is it?

The dual-sort system uses two bins. One bin for fiber paper materials and one bin for plastic, steel, glass and aluminum containers. Sorting paper and containers enhance our recycling program by adding more materials and improving the quality of what is recycled.

How will it work?

A container is for fiber paper materials including newspaper (with inserts), phonebooks, cardboard, cereal boxes, snack boxes, junk mail, magazines and mixed office paper.

Another is for containers including aluminum & steel cans, glass bottles & plastic containers coded...



Why Recycle?

Increasing recycling can save you money on future disposal costs, besides saving resources.

Helpful hints

- Residents may put paper materials in a paper grocery bag and place the bag on top of their containers, using a single bin system.



- If you have large cardboard boxes, please fold/flatten to a 3'x3' size and stack them between or under bins.
